# HOW TO:

### PAINT A SELLWOOD ATTIC LADDER WITH A MELAMINE LID.

Some Sellwood attic ladders come standard with a flush, prefinished, melamine lid, but you may want to paint the surface to match your décor.

#### METHOD 1 – Sand and paint

- 1. Roughen up the melamine lid surface using 60 or 80g sandpaper (you do not need to sand off all the melamine just enough to ensure the paint will stick).
- 2. Clean the surface thoroughly with a damp cloth or sugar wipes to remove all dirt, dust and loose material and allow surface to dry.
- 3. Apply 1 2 coats of <u>Resene Quick Dry Waterborne Primer Undercoat</u> and lightly sand between coats for a smooth professional finish.
- 4. Apply 1 2 coats of suitable top coat to match your décor.

#### METHOD 2 – Smooth surface sealer

- 1. Clean the surface thoroughly with a damp cloth or sugar wipes to remove all dirt, dust and loose material and allow surface to dry.
- 2. Apply 1 coat of Resene Waterborne Smooth Surface Sealer.
- 3. Apply 1 2 coats of <u>Resene Quick Dry Waterborne Primer Undercoat</u> and lightly sand between coats for a smooth professional finish.
- 4. Apply 1 2 coats of suitable top coat to match your décor.
